On September 1, 2016, WSPP Inc. (WSPP) submitted for filing revisions to the WSPP Agreement. Specifically, WSPP has amended Schedule Q of the WSPP Agreement to reflect PacifiCorp's recently revised cost-based rates, which were approved by the Commission on August 16, 2016, in Docket No. ER16-1964-000, as well as certain ministerial corrections. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's rules and regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted, and the tariff records are accepted for filing, effective June 9, 2016, as requested.

The filing was noticed on September 1, 2016, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before September 22, 2016. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and
